Normal Conditionals

IF. C.	<u>Should</u> aux.	//	<u>M.V. :</u> Inf. (-to)
-----------	-----------------------	----	-----------------------------

[Should they not fire ...] IF.C.
aux. s. neg. m.v.

IF. C.	<u>Were</u> aux.	//	<u>M.V. :</u> Inf. (+to)
-----------	---------------------	----	-----------------------------

[Were I to break ...] IF.C.
aux. s. m.v.

IF. C.	<u>Had</u> aux.	//	<u>M.V. :</u> The same
-----------	--------------------	----	---------------------------

[Had I had ...] IF.C.
aux. s. m.v.
